

CHAMBER CHOIR OF WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF LIFE SCIENCES (WULS) was established in March 2014 from the initiative of the Director of People's Artistic Group "Promni" Radosław Puszyło and with the consent of the then Rector of Warsaw University of Life Sciences, Sc. D. Alojzy Szymański as part of the expansion of activities of the Zofia Solarzowa LZA "Promni" Warsaw University of Life Sciences.

The first conductor and spiritus movens of the group was Ph. D. Joanna Maluga. Since 2018, the choir has been led by Paweł Choina with Magdalena Gruziel as the assistant conductor.

The goal of the choir's activity is to develop the musical culture and vocal skills of choristers, as well as to represent and promote the University through participation in WULS ceremonies, competitions, festivals and choir reviews as well as concerts in Poland and abroad.

The Chamber Choir of Warsaw University of Life Sciences in Warsaw debuted less than a month after it was established, during a symposium on the occasion of the canonization of John Paul II in the Crystal Hall of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences in Warsaw on April 2, 2014.

The Choir regularly participates in ceremonies at the University, including in the inauguration of the academic year, during the awarding of diplomas, Christmas meetings and the WULS Days. It cooperates with LZA "Promni", the WULS Orchestra and the WULS Academic Choir.

The choristers develop their skills during vocal and acting workshops under the supervision of authorities from Poland and abroad, including Philip Lawson, former singer of the band "The King's Singers" (Great Britain), vocal ensemble "XCor" (Venezuela), Sc. D. Elżbieta Wtorkowska (Nowowiejski Academy of Music in Bydgoszcz), Sc. D. Agnieszka Franków-Żelazny (Lipiński Academy of Music in Wrocław), Olga Wądołowska from the "Monday Girls" Vocal Ensemble, Bartłomiej Magdziarz – actor, graduate of the Acting Department of the Theatre Academy in Warsaw.

In 2016, the Chamber Choir of WULS took part in the celebrations of 200th anniversary of the University and appeared on the stage of the Grand Theater's National Opera in Warsaw accompanied by the TW – ON Orchestra, LZA "Promni" and many distinguished guests. Another jubilee concert took place in the Amphitheatre of the Royal Łazienki Park in Warsaw.

An important event in the life of the choir was the premiere of the anthem of WULS in Warsaw to lyrics of Marianna Olszewska and music of Mikołaj Gąsiorek, which since June 2016 is the official anthem of the Warsaw University of Life Sciences.
